Barn opens at 4:00pm, Friday June 26th for any early arrivals.

Cattle and Swine Check in opens at 7am to 9am on Saturday the 27th

Sheep and Goat Check in opens noon to 2pm on Saturday the 27th

Sunday Registration and check in will be at 7am to 8:30 only for NEW cattle and Swine entries. Show will start promptly at 9am

Sunday Registration and check in for NEW sheep and goat by 12:30pm Show will start promptly at 1pm

Weigh-ins will be on each exhibitor to fill out a weight card and have into the registration table before 9am on Saturday and for New entries for beef and swine BY 8:30am on Sunday.

Breeding animals will not be weighed in, but will still need to be checked in.

Market Shows Saturday & Sunday

*open to exhibitors ages 4-21

*weights turned in at designated times on entry cards

*classes broken evenly by weight, determined by show committee

*Sunday registration only open to NEW entries

Breeding Show (Saturday afternoon)

***open to all exhibitors & breeding females**

*gilts – shown by weight

*ewes & does – (<1year) with aged class(es) for females over 1 year

Ewes and does shown by weight if born in June 2019 or after.

January-May 2019 = junior yearling

June-Dec 2018 = senior yearling

May 2018 and earlier = aged

*heifers – shown by age

*all class breaks determined by show committee

**RMJSS points will only be awarded to exhibitors age 4-21 with does and ewes under 1 year as of show day, and heifers born after August 1.

overall champion and reserve females will be selected for the I-80 Extravaganza, then a champion and reserve for RMJSS points will be selected (if necessary)

Showmanship (Sunday, at the beginning of each species)

Ages as of January 1, 2020

- Pewee Division is 4-8 years old & can handle their animal.
- Junior Division for ages 9-11
- Intermediate Division for ages 12-15
- Senior Division for ages 16-21

General Information

* Market Show is open to any age from 4-21 as of January 1, 2020.

* Breeding show is OPEN to all ages.

I-80 Extravaganza Jackpot will follow all General Rules of the RMJSS Jackpots as outlined on their website.

****NO** animals exhibiting signs of fungus, infections or other contagious health issues will be allowed to remain in the barns. At first sign of an issue, the show committee will inspect and handle with their best judgement, asking the exhibitor to take the animal to their trailer if possible, or to remove animal from the grounds.

****NO** animal will be allowed to show if it is lame or injured. The exhibitor will be asked to take the animal back to their stall and proper attention will be given.

* Out of state swine will need a USDA Premises Tag.

* Beef and sheep will need brand inspection.

* Sheep and Goats will need scrapie tags in place.

Bedding will **NOT** be provided. Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning pens during and after the show.
