1. The Number 1 Rule is: Everyone Must Have Fun.
2. The Les Bois Spring Classic will be under the direction of Kirk & Sheryl Pugsley for Swine Show & Steer & Market Heifer Show. Britany Cunningham for Sheep & Goat Show.
3. The Les Bois Spring Classic will be sanctioned by The Snake River Show Circuit. We will also be sanctioned through the Rocky Mountain Jackpot Show Series.
4. Proper show ring attire is required and should follow standard 4-H or FFA guidelines. No open toed shoes, short pants, tank tops or shirts not covering the shoulder or midriff accepted.
5. There will be no refund of entry fees.
6. Sawdust pen bedding must be used.
7. Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning of pens before leaving the grounds; Failure to do so will result in forfeit of premiums.
8. The show manager will handle any problems, questions, and situations before, during or after the show that may arise covered or otherwise not covered by the printed rules. Any and all decisions will be at the discretion of the Show Managers, and will be final, and not subject to appeal.
9. All entries must be postmarked by Friday May 24th to receive the \$25/head pre-registration fee. After May 24th, \$40/head fee. Entries must be made on the entry form, and photocopies will be accepted.
10. Show open to youth 2-19 years old as of January 1 of the current year.
11. All pigs will be weighed, and classes will be set after completion of weigh-in.
12. Any hogs weighing 300 pounds and under are welcome. No max weight for market lambs, or market goats or market steers & heifers.
13. Check in and weigh in will be as follows:
 - Hogs: 6-8 pm Friday May 31st, 8-10 am Saturday, June 1st 8-10, & 7-8 am Sunday, June 2nd.
 - Sheep & Goats: 6-8 pm Friday, May 31st, 8-10 am Saturday, June 1st 8-10
 - Market Heifers/Steers: 6-8 pm Friday, May 31st, 8-10 am Saturday, June 1st 8-10
14. Swine weights established at Stateline Showcase weigh in will be used for Les Bois Spring Classic.
15. 100% of entry fees will go into the Jackpot.
16. All livestock from outside of Idaho must have proper health papers. Consult your veterinarian.
17. All animals must be free of diseases. We reserve the right to remove or reject any animal due to health concerns.
18. Proof of ownership will be required at check in.
19. Exhibitors are responsible for the care and grooming of their own animals. We encourage parent assistance keeping in mind this is a Jr. Show.
20. All exhibitors are encouraged to enter Showmanship. Prizes will be awarded for Showmanship.
21. Showmanship is open to all that are registered before the show begins.
22. Showmanship will be divided by age of the participant.
