## GENERAL RULES:

1. **Integrity is expected.**
2. Show is open to youth age 20 years and under as of July 13, 2019.
3. Animals will be identified by ear tag number and classed by weight, hip height or DOB at check in.
4. Entry fees are listed on the entry form. If an exhibitor has more than one animal in the same class, they may have assistance from another show exhibitor.
5. **No refunds of entry fees will be given. Entries will not be accepted without accompanying payment.**
6. Showmanship age groups:

Senior	17-20
Intermediate	13-16
Junior	9-12
Peewee	8 and under

  - Peewee exhibitors will be awarded prizes, not buckles. There must be a minimum of 5 Peewee exhibitors entered to continue its own class. If there are less than 5 exhibitors entered, Peeweewees will show with the Junior class, but still receive Peewee awards. Age is AS OF July 13, 2019.
7. Heifers and steers must be halter broke. Animals that are unmanageable will be asked to leave.
8. Heifers must be under 24 months of age as of the show date. Steers, lambs, hogs and goats must be of the feeder type and kind.
9. By signing and returning the entry form, each exhibitor agrees that he/she is responsible for any loss, injury, or damage that results to him/her, his/her officers, agents, employees or animals.
10. The entry deadline is July 5, 2019. Late entries will be charged \$50 extra per class. Late entries close at 7:00am the morning of the show - NO EXCEPTIONS.
11. The top two animals from each market weight class will return for selection of Grand and Reserve Champion in their respective class. Weight classes will be determined the day of the show based on entries.
12. The management of Montana Royal Junior Livestock Show has the right to interpret these rules as they see fit. Their decision is FINAL! Judge's decision is FINAL! You get what you get and you don't throw a fit!
13. **Exhibitors are expected to clean up after themselves and their animal(s). Please give yourself enough time to thoroughly clean up your area. Management will check off each area prior to the exhibitor leaving the premises.**
14. Proper courtesy and conduct are required by exhibitors and spectators at all times. If you can't behave, you will be invited to leave.
15. Montana Royal is a non-terminal show.

## PRIZES AND AWARDS

1. 80% Payback. Jackpot money will be split and determined based on the number of entries and class sizes. Jackpot money only applies to market classes.
2. Grand Champion Market Animals will receive belt buckles.
3. Grand Champion Showmen will receive belt buckles. No money will be awarded in showmanship.
4. Grand Champion Wether Dams (lambs & does) and Heifers will receive belt buckles. No money will be awarded in breeding classes.
5. Awards will be given first to fifth place overall in market, breeding and showmanship.
