Rules and Regulations:

1. Blow and Go Show rules will be enforced: Animals may be clipped, blown and brushed to enhance their appearance
 - a. Beef animals must be shown free of any adhesives, glue, paint or powder products
 - b. Any compounds that have adhesive qualities that when applied cannot be combed or brushed through or alter the color of the animal are forbidden. These products include, but are not limited to commonly used adhesives and colorants such as Prime Time, EZ comb, Tail Adhesive, Ultra White Touch Up, Black Touch Up, Black Finisher and Black show foam.
 - c. Alcohol, water, oil, or any water or alcohol-based products with no adhesive or glue qualities, or artificial colorings are permitted. These products include conditioners and commonly used sprays such as Kleen Sheen, Revive, Final Bloom and White show foam.
2. Steers will be shown by hip height, no breed classes.
3. Heifers will be shown by age. Must be born after January 1, 2018. No breed classes.
4. Ranch Raised steer class must have a signed affidavit stating no club calf genetics.
5. Exhibitors are responsible for any loss, injury or damage that may result from his or her animals to them, their agents, employees, other exhibitors or their property.
6. Bedding will be available for \$7 per bag absolutely no straw allowed in the barn.
7. In the case of cold weather there will be no wash rack available and in the case of below zero weather, show will be cancelled.
8. Exhibitors showmanship age classifications as of January 1, 2018
Pee Wee 7 & under, Junior – 8-11, Intermediate 12–15, Senior 16–21.
9. Exhibitors must be members of 4-H, FFA, or a Junior Breed Association
10. All out of state exhibitors will need health records.
11. Times are subject to change based on numbers and will be announced.
12. Concessions will be available.
